Case 1. CSVP 2010-2617 (Q99-193, Pingtung county LDCC, M.T. Tsai, W.L. Chen, M.L. Lee, S.T. Huang, J.P. Hsu)

Goat, alpine, two-year-old, showed clinical signs of lethargy, anorexia, and dyspnea.

Case 2. CSVP 2010-2618 (99-064, Tainan Hsien LDCC, C.M. Ou, A.N. Huang, C.N. Hung, K.Y. Tsai)

Eclectus parrot, 1-week-old, showed signs of hepatomegaly and urate deposited in the kidney. The morbidity was 2/200 and mortality was 2/200.

Case 3. CSVP 2010-2619 (P99080, Kaohsiung county AHIQI, W.C. Chen, C.T. Wu, C.B. Chao)

Goat, about 1-year-old, the gross finding, pneumonia especially was noted when sampling the diagnosed case of goatpox.

Case 4. CSVP 2010-2620 (D99-20195, NPUST, C.S. Hung, T.C. Chang, C.D. Chang, N.K. Yu, S.S. Tsai)

Canine, 7-year-old, male, German shepherd, showed clinical signs of anorexia, vomiting and depression.

Case 5. CSVP 2010-2621 (D99-20160, NPUST, C.W. Chang, T.C. Chang, C.D. Chang, N.K. Yu, S.S. Tsai)

Cloned cow, six-year-old, female, showed clinical signs of tachypnea and respiratory distress.

Case 6. CSVP 2010-2622 (WA99-2340, NPUST, Y.H. Hsu, T.C. Chang, C.D. Chang, N.K. Yu, S.S. Tsai)

Macaca cyclopis (Formosan rock-monkey), adult, female, showed clinical signs of anorexia for 2 years.
