**Case 1. CSVP 2011-2666 (CM-140, NCYU, H.T. Ling, Z.J. Zheng, D.Y. Lo)**

Stray feline, 2-month-old, showed signs of depression, anorexia, abdominal masses and swelling with a fluid wave when palpation. Gross findings: multiple white spots in multi-organ (lung, liver, spleen).

**Case 2. CSVP 2011-2667 (ATAHT10002, TACTRI, L.H. Chang, C.H. Yang)**

SD rat, 8-week-old, male. This rat was found suddenly death after "the acute oral toxicity experiment of rat". After necropsy, gastric hemorrhage was found.

**Case 3. CSVP 2011-2668 (CO11-0644, GIVP, NCHU, C.Y. Chu, C.A. Wu, R.B. Kao, S.Y. Chiou, J.W. Liao)**

Hamster, 2.5 yr-old, intact female. A mass from the right abdomen of the hamster was measured about 2.5×2×2 cm and weighed 3.0 g after surgical removal.

**Case 4. CSVP 2011-2669 (CS11-0914, ADCC, NCHU, H.S. Huang, W.F. Chang)**

Canine, about 4-year-old, male. A mass from the interdigital end of right fore limb was measured about 2×1.3×1 cm after surgical removal.

**Case 5. CSVP 2011-2670 (CO11-745B, NCHU, W.H. Yei, C.C. Lin)**

Weaned pigs showed coughing and nasal discharge, the morbidity was 50% (500/1,000), and no mortality in this period. Catarrh to fibrinous exudate was found in the nasal sinus.

**Case 6. CSVP 2011-2671 (CO11-0626B, NCHU, C.C. Liu, C.C. Lin)**

Feline, 13-year-old, neutered female, showed anorexia, emaciation, depression and deep breathing and large amount of hydrothorax with pronounced abdominal effort.
