Case 1. CSVP 2013-2723 (SAHIPS03 604, TACTRI, L.H. Chang, C.H. Yang)

Wistar rat, 10-week-old, male, sudden death with bleeding from urethra, and a mass about 3.5x 3.0x 2.5 cm was noted on left kidney at necropsy.

Case 2. CSVP 2013-2724(CD12021, NCYU, W. C. Chi, H. C. Kuo, C.L. Chen, D.Y. Lo)

Parrot, agapornis, 15-week-old, showed depression and anorexia. Scabs were observed on their unfeathered skin. The morbidity was 30% (60/200) and mortality was 5% (10/200). (Slide scanned on the IVP, NCHU website, no glass slide).

Case 3. CSVP 2013-2725 (CO12-839, IVP NCHU, Y.H. Hsu, J.W. Liao)

Hamster, male, 1.5 year-old, a hard mass, 3 cm x 2 cm x 3.5 cm, yellowish-white necrotic foci with exudative fluid, was found on the right thoracic subcutis.

Case 4. CSVP 2013-2726 (CO12-0992B, IVP NCHU H.T. Wu, T. C. Liu, C.C. Lin)

Feline, 2-month-old, from an animal shelter, showed sign of diarrhea, but no obvious gross lesion.

Case 5. CSVP 2013-2727 (CM12-0102, ADDC NCHU, H.H. Hung, W.F. Chang)

Piglet, from a farrowing pig farm with an inventory of approximately 150 sows, clinical signs of yellow, pasty to watery diarrhea, dehydration and sunken eyes were noticed 1~5-week-old piglets and sows.

Case 6. CSVP 2013-2728 (CS12-0924K, NCHU, S.L. Lin, T. C. Liu, C.C. Lin)

Canine, Akita, 8-month-old, showed fever, pancytopenia and was unable to stand. The dog was treated by steroid.
