**Case 1. CSVP 2013-2748 (P101-132, Kaohsiung City Animal Protection Office, W.C. Chen, C.T. Wu, C.B. Chao, C.F. Cheng)**

Racing pigeon, 40-day-old, showed clinical signs of anorexia, depression, thirst and severe watery diarrhea. Some pigeons died within 3 days after therapy, and torticollis(wryneck) of neurological syndrome were observed in the survival pigeons. The mortality was about 40% (12/30).

**Case 2. CSVP 2013-2749 (Q102-1, Pingtung County LDCC, M.T. Tsai, I.P. Lu, W.L. Chen, C.H.Chang, S.T. Huang, J.P. Hsu)**

Dairy Cattle, Holstein, 3-year-old, female, showed signs of fever and severe respiratory distress. The morbidity and mortality were about 7.3% (12/164) and 2.4% (4/164), respectively.

**Case 3. CSVP 2013-2750 (NTU2012-1888, GIMCP, NTU, Y.C. Liao, C.R. Jeng)**

Canine, Shih-Tzu, 14-year-old, neutered female. A mass in nictitating membrane was noted on 2012/8/28. The nictitan growth was getting larger and larger, therefore, the owner decided to excise the mass on 2012/11/23.

**Case 4. CSVP 2013-2751 (SP102-7111, NPUST, H.Y. Hsu, C.D. Chang, T.C. Chang)**

Feline, Persian, 8-year-old, female, showed clinical signs of renal dysfunction. A mass in the neck was found about 6 months before sickness.

**Case 5. CSVP 2013-2752 (SP102-7054, NPUST, C.Y. Lin, C.D. Chang, T.C. Chang)**

Canine, 8-year-old, castrated male. A mass was noted adhered with the pancreas, kidney, mesentery and intestine in abdominal cavity.

**Case 6. CSVP 2013-2753 (D101-22089, NPUST, F.Y. Cheng, C.D. Chang, T.C. Chang)**

Canine, Welsh Corgi, 4-year-old, male. The clinical symptoms presented pyrexia, anorexia, melena and icterus. The blood chemistry analysis presented liver failure, renal failure and thrombocytopenia. The patient died in the next few days, and the necropsy was performed.
