**Case 1. CSVP 2014-2779 (CD14004, ADDC NCYU, Y.H. Yu, H.J. Kuo, D.Y. Lo)**

Suckling piglet, 3 to 4-day-old, showed signs of yellow or bloody diarrhea, and the sow diarrhea, too. The morbidity was 50%, and the mortality was approximately 50%.

**Case 2. CSVP 2014-2780 (NLAC, S132071, C.T. Liang, K.J. Ling, Y.L. Chen)**

SJL/J mouse, 13-month-old, hepatomegaly, splenomegaly, wet tissues submitted for histopathological diagnosis.

**Case 3. CSVP 2014-2781 (CO13-1031, GIVP, NCHU, H.K. Chang, J.H. Shien, C.C. Lin)**

Giant grouper (*Epinephelus lanceolatus*), about 25-30 cm body length, showed feeding retardation and low activity. Five to six fishes dead per day.

**Case 4. CSVP 2014-2782 (CW13-044, GIVP, NCHU, R.S. Chen, Y.T. Tien, K.S. Yueh, F.T. Chan, J.W. Liao)**

Leopard cat, unknown age, intact female, showed multiple yellow to white nodules in multiple organs such as lung, liver, spleen and kidney at necropsy. A focal infarction in kidney was noticed.

**Case 5. CSVP 2014-2783 (NTU2013-1749, GIMCP, NTU, Y.C. Liao, C.R. Jeng)**

American shorthair cat, 3-year-old, had been vomiting and anorexia since 7/27, 2013. Fever, leukopenia, jaundice, and hypoalbuminemia were noted on 7/31, 2013. Endoscopy and exploratory laparotomy were performed on 8/1, 2013. Hyperemia, swelling, and nodule were detected on ascending and transverse and proximal descending colon, ileum, and ascending colon, anastomosis was performed.

**Case 6. CSVP 2014-2784 (NTU2013-1856, GIMCP, NTU, C.C. Lin, C.H. Liu)**

Persian cat, unknown age, intact male, comes to the hospital for ill eye and panophthalmitis was tentatively diagnosed by the clinician.
