**Case 1. CSVP 2014-2785 (CD13-083, NCYU, L.C. SU, C.L. Chen, H.C. Kuo, D.Y. Lo)**

Nursery pig, approximately 5-week-old, showed clinical signs of stiffness, tremors and reluctance to move. The mortality was about 80%.

**Case 2. CSVP 2014-2786 (CD13-078, NCYU, Y.J. Lee, C.L. Chen, H.C. Kuo, D.Y. Lo)**

Goose, 1-year-old, showed clinical signs of depression, weak foot and crust on webbed feet. The mortality was 0.58% (21/3,600).

**Case 3. CSVP 2014-2787 (CM13-1012B, NCHU ADDC, H.K. Chung, W.F. Chung, C.C. Lin)**

Pig, 3 to 10-week-old, from a 1,000-sow farrow-to-finish farm, showed convulsion and paralysis after replace the forage to complete feed. Far from 20 km away, another farm which used the same feed was observed the same clinical syndrome. Tiamulin has been added into the diet by owner. Morbidity was about 100% and the lethality was high.

**Case 4. CSVP 2014-2788 (102029-B, NTUCM LAC, Y.T. Tsai, S.L. Chen, W.P. Chen, H.W. Chen)**

Mouse, 4-month-old, the p53 knockout mouse showed signs of head tilting and circling to the right.

**Case 5. CSVP 2014-2789 (NTU2013-261, GIMCP, NTU, J.W. Jiang, F.I. Wang)**

Canine, Maltese, 4-year-old, intact male, with history of dysphagia for about 3 weeks. The clinical sign including vomit, halitosis, gingival inflammation, oral mucosa ulceration and digits of all limbs and perianal region were pruritus.

**Case 6. CSVP 2014-2790 (NTU2013-1405, Y.C. Chang, P.H. Chang)**

Canine, Golden retriever, 10-year-old, female. The mass on right mandibular gingival was noted in half year. It had been excised twice without pathologic diagnosis. Osteoproliferation at right mandibular was noted on radiology.
